 - to collect, celebrate and share good practices

MARCH 2020

- Launch of the Covid19 Teaching & Learning Support Network (on Teams)
 - Space for all colleagues, all questions
- Evolution of questioning about...
 - Technology how do I use X?
 - Pedagogy how can I teach Y?
 - Practices how do I do Z in this way?
- Helping colleagues locally
 - School-wide conversational webinars on working remotely, mental health

- A move from 'emergency remote' thinking to a focus on the future

 - Fewer Teams = good!
